When we embrace the constant change of putting off the old and putting on the new, God gives us a sense of deep satisfaction.

1. Recognize the need to change (vs. 17–19)

- My mind needs to be renewed
- My heart needs to be softened
- My life needs to be restored

2. Embrace the process of change (vs. 20–24)

- Put off the old
- Put on the new

3. Enjoy the results of change (vs. 25–32)

- Character—unquestionable integrity
- Attitude—radical self-control
- Priorities—uncommon selflessness
- Speech—constant encouragement
- Relationships—divine kindness

Some Clear Challenges:

- Don't give the devil any reason to celebrate over your life (vs. 27)
- Don't give the Holy Spirit any reason to mourn over your life (vs. 30)
