## Why It's OK to Not Be OK

—Psalms 95, 36, 130, and 99

*Part 8 of a series from the Book of Psalms titled: "It's OK to Not Be OK"*

*It's OK to not be OK because God loves you as you are,  
but He loves you far too much to leave you that way.*

### 1. **Creation** (Psalm 95:3–5)

***Where did everything come from?***

God created everything, and everything was good (Genesis 1–2)

- Provided us intimacy with God
- Gave us purpose from God
- Made us accountable to God

### 2. **Fall** (Psalm 36:1–4)

***What went wrong?***

Adam and Eve disobeyed God, and everything fell under condemnation

(Genesis 3)

*(I am a broken person living in a broken world with other broken people)*

- Repentance toward God
- Forgiveness of others
- Patience in life

### 3. **Redemption** (Psalm 130:1–4)

***How can we have hope?***

God sent His Son, and the curse was destroyed (Romans 8)

- All of creation has hope
- Every person can have hope

## 4. Restoration (Psalm 99:1–5)

### *Where is everything going?*

God has made, is making, and will make all things new (Revelation 21, 2 Corinthians 5)

- Walk with God
- Engage with God's family
- Become like Jesus
- Bring others to Christ
